VAS9 - VAS LTD STATE FINAL RICH FRUIT CAKE

Open to VAS Rich Fruitcake regional finalists only. Exhibitors must use the following recipe:

VAS RICH FRUIT CAKE:

250g each sultanas, chopped raisins, currants, 125g mixed peel (chopped), 90g red glace cherries (chopped), 90g blanched almonds (chopped), 1/3 cup sherry or brandy, 250g plain flour, 60g self-raising flour, $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon grated nutmeg, $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon each ground ginger and ground cloves, 250g butter, 250g soft brown sugar, $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon each almond essence and vanilla essence, $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon lemon essence or finely grated lemon rind, 4 large eggs.

METHOD:

Mix together all fruits and nuts and sprinkle with sherry or brandy. Cover and leave for at least 1 hour, but preferably overnight. Sift together the flours and spices. Cream together the butter and sugar with the essences. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition, then alternately add the fruit and flour mixtures. Mix thoroughly. The mixture should be stiff enough to support a wooden spoon. Place the mixture into a prepared 20cm square, straight sided, square cornered tin, and bake in a slow oven for approximately $3\frac{1}{2}$ to 4 hours or until cooked when tested. Allow the cake to cool in the tin.

NOTE: To ensure uniformity, and depending upon the size, it is suggested the raisins be snipped into 2 or 3 pieces; cherries into 4-6 pieces and almonds crosswise into 3-4 pieces.

VAS10 - VAS LTD STATE FINAL JUNIOR BOILED FRUIT CAKE

Open to VAS Junior Boiled Fruitcake regional finalists only.

Exhibitors must use the following recipe:

VAS JUNIOR BOILED FRUIT CAKE:

375g mixed fruit, $\frac{3}{4}$ cup brown sugar, 1 teaspoon mixed spice, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup water, 125g butter, $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon bi-carb soda, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup sherry, 2 eggs lightly beaten, 2 tablespoons marmalade, 1 cup self-raising flour, 1 cup plain flour, $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon salt.

METHOD:

Place the mixed fruit, sugar, spice, water and butter in a large saucepan and bring to the boil. Simmer gently for 3 minutes, then remove from stove and add bi-carb soda. Allow to cool then add the sherry, eggs and marmalade, mixing well. Fold in the sifted dry ingredients then place in a greased and lined 20cm round cake tin. Bake in a moderately slow oven for $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours, or until cake is cooked when tested.
